

AVERAGE DAILY SCHEDULE

2:30—3:00 Chill and Chat

Keiki will check-in with their respective group leaders, eat snacks that they have brought*, and unwind from the school day. Please provide your keiki with afternoon snacks and a water bottle. Students may refill their water bottles at available water fountains/coolers.

**Due to the presence of known and unknown allergies, please no sharing of snacks outside of sblings.*

3:00—3:45 Creative Classroom

Keiki will work on homework, other academic activities such as reading or creative writing, and/or staff-led STEAM enrichment activities.

3:45—4:00 Cafeteria Cleanup

All kids and staff will assist in cleaning the cafeteria before they transition to outside time.

4:00—4:30 Group Games

Keiki will participate in fun group games that incorporate the Y's core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility. Activities will be located by the main student drop-off/pick-up areas including the courtyard playground by the kindergarten classrooms, the upper field and playground, and the blacktop on Fridays when it is available.

The location of each group will be indicated by a colored flag as follows:

Kinder-2nd: **YELLOW**

3rd-4th: **BLUE**

5th-6th: **ORANGE**

4:30—5:00 Free Play

Kids will have supervised independent play with their own age groups.

5:00—6:00 Pick-Up

Monday—Thursday: Kids will convene at the upper field and play ground for pick-up by parents.

Friday: Kids will convene on the blacktop when available from 4-6PM.

A combination of free play and group games will be available for students to choose from.

ASP DATES/TIMES:

ASP will be following your child’s school year calendar. Program will start on the 1st day students report to school. Kindergarten participants start on their 1st full day of school. The last day of program will be the last day of school. ASP hours are from school’s dismissal bell to 6:00 P.M., including all early dismissals.

ASP General Information:

- **Program Fee:** \$120.00 per month
- **Absences:** Please call or text the Na Pua Lei cell phone at 808-291-8140 if your child will be absent from program.
- **Snacks:** Parents must provide snack. Due to allergies, please no sharing of snacks outside of siblings.
- **Activities:** Staff will run various curriculum such as Arts and Crafts, Kid Science, Games and Sports. Study Hall will be scheduled in daily.
- **Pick-Up:** Children shall be picked up only by parents, guardians, or other persons authorized on registration form. To ensure the safety of the children, I.D. cards must be shown and signed out with a Y staff member. Parents must give advance permission if child is to be picked up by someone else or child is to walk, take the bus, etc.
- **Late Pick-Up:** A \$5.00 late fee shall be imposed for every 15 minute beyond 6 P.M. Habitual late pick-up may result in termination from program.

PAYMENT/CANCELLATION POLICY:

Monthly payment is due on or before the 1st day of every month. If monthly fee is not paid within the first 5 program days of the month, your child will be withdrawn on the 6th program day. Fees are distributed throughout the school year as listed on the payment schedule. There will be no refunds for unused/missed days. A late payment fee of \$5.00 per day (up to \$25.00 max) will be assessed for all late payments. A \$25.00 fee will be applied for any declined check or credit card payments returned from your financial institution. Cancellations/withdrawals from the program must be submitted in writing before the end of the child’s last month of attendance.

ELECTRONIC FUND TRANSFER (EFT):

Automatic payments or an EFT can be set up through your credit card, savings or checking account. Forms to sign up are available at the Kaimuki-Waialae YMCA office.

DHS REIMBURSEMENT PAPERWORK:

Parents receiving DHS benefits and need their DHS 918 Childcare Certificate and Provider Confirmation Form completed must pay for the program in full.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

The Kaimuki-Waialae YMCA believes its’ programs and services should be accessible to everyone. Through the generosity of donors, the Y is able to provide financial assistance to those families in need.
